

Biotin Injections Vitamin B7

Preparation

Avoid consuming alcohol for at least 24 hours before your Biotin injection, as it can thin the blood and elevate the risk of bruising.

Additionally, don't take any blood-thinning medications, including aspirin or anti-inflammatory drugs, for at least 3 days prior to your treatment. Please discuss with your prescriber before attending for your injection.

After-care

- Keep the injection site clean and dry to prevent infection.
- Rest and stay hydrated for the first 24 hours to help your body absorb the biotin.
- Watch for side effects like pain, swelling, or mild digestive issues. If anything feels severe, contact a healthcare provider.
- Avoid alcohol and blood-thinning medications for a short period before and after the injection to reduce bruising.
- Follow any dietary recommendations that support biotin levels, such as eating biotin-rich foods and / or taking supplements if advised.
